

Lesson Plan 3 - An Overview

This Diocese of Armagh Board of Religious Education Lesson Plan 3 (The Life of Jesus) has been designed to link specifically to the following:

Foundation Level P1.

Learning Objective 1: The Revelation of God (The Life of Jesus)

Pupils should begin to develop an awareness, knowledge, understanding and appreciation of the key Christian teachings about God (Father, Son and Holy Spirit) about Jesus Christ and about the Bible; and begin to develop an ability to interpret and relate the Bible to life.

The Life of Jesus

f. Demonstrate knowledge of the main events of the death of Jesus and his burial.

Pupils should be able to:

- Talk about special meals and the special meals that Jesus would have had.
- Talk about some of the people who disliked Jesus.
- Listen to the story of how Jesus died because He loves people.
- Make a cross.
- · Create their own empty tomb.
- Dramatise the discovery of the empty tomb.

g. Demonstrate knowledge that Jesus is alive.

Pupils should be able to:

- Talk about how Jesus' friends might have felt when they heard that the tomb was empty.
- Make an Easter garden/card.
- Make or collect items for an Easter table: have mustard or cress seeds growing, spring flowers, models of lambs or chicks.
- Make a frieze of new life at springtime.
- Talk about where Jesus lives today.

Prayer:	Thank you God for Easter and the brand new life of Spring. Amen.
Suggestions for parents:	Religious Education enables the child to develop spiritual and moral values and come to a knowledge of God. The teacher aims to work in partnership with parents to continue in school much of what is being done at home. By taking an interest in the worksheets or pictures they bring home, parents will be playing an important part in their child's faith development. They will help them to grow in faith, in knowledge of God and in love of God's word.






