

Handprint Wisemen Activity

1. Camels: Have the children trace around their hands on brown card (three times) and cut out.

(Alternatively, the project could be started earlier in the day and brown paint could be used to make handprints, with the project continuing once the paint had dried)

2. Ground Cover: Cut out and glue down, or colour in sand/grass/snow to make ground cover.
3. Camels: Glue down/hand print upside down 'camels'.
4. Kings: Add thumbprints in three different coloured inks. Once ink is dry, embellish kings/camels with pens/crayons (don't forget the camels' tails!)
5. Star: Stamp/trace and cut out and glue down/draw yellow star. Maybe glitter??
6. Pre-printed strips: ('They followed the star to worship the Lord Jesus'), glued down.

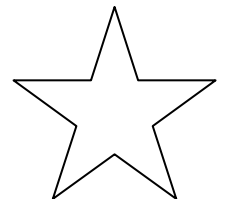
Dark blue A3 card

to worship Lord Jesus

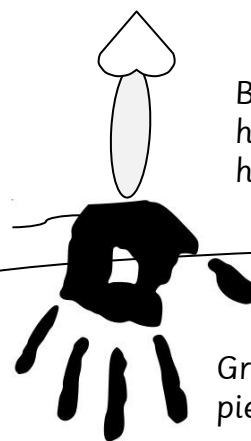
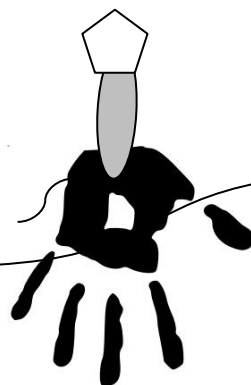
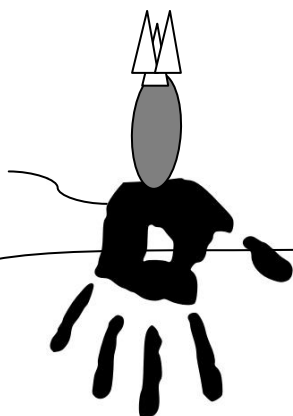
Cut out paper star
